In Association with the British Council, we are excited to announce the launch of **Your World Video Making Competition for 2021-2022**. Building on the success of previous Your World competitions, we are pleased to inform you that the theme for this year's competition is **Urban living: sustainable cities and communities**.



There will be one global winning group. **The global prize is divided into 3 categories:**

- **Students:** A free online film course delivered by an internationally recognized film school from the UK. All participants will receive a certificate of completion. An iPad will be awarded to each member of the winning team.
- **Teachers:** Free Aptis test for up to 10 teachers from the winning partner school.
- **Global Winning Partner School:** The winning school will be awarded a trophy. There will also be an exclusive opportunity to be hosted in our social media live event to celebrate the success of the winning Partner School and their students in Your World competition 2021/2022.

We are inviting students to make a live action video or animated style video that focuses on finding solutions that make our cities and communities safer, resilient, and sustainable. The social action project should aim to make our cities more sustainable through actions that deal with an issue for a community of your choice.

In making their video, students will be able to draw on their cross-curricular knowledge while developing the core skills of leadership, digital literacy, creativity, collaboration critical thinking and problem solving. The experience of making this video could also be used strengthen a future overseas university application.

Students will be working in groups of three to five to make this video. There will be one age group category for this years' competition: Students aged between 14 and 17.
